**Test Qualifications:**    Apply as of November 24, 2011,

**Age Restrictions:**      All events restricted to skaters under the age of 18 years.

**Dance Music:**            All dance events will be skated to Skate Canada Dance  
Music Series 8.

**Solo Music:**              All solo music will have a 10 second allowance

**Medals and Awards:** The Awards Ceremony will take place in the William Lea  
Room after the completion of the Competition.

**Please note:** The Competition Committee reserves the right to cancel events if there  
are not sufficient registrants and to sub divide events according to age.

## Singles Events

### Elements - For Bronze Level Skaters Only)

Skaters must perform the specific elements in the order in which they are listed below. Coverage of ice is important. Connecting foot work may be included. Background music will be supplied. Please ask your coach which of the three element Events (Blue Purple and Green) you should be entered in..

#### **Blue:**

Two foot jump – Forwards- backwards  
One foot Spin  
Forward Crosscuts

#### **Purple:**

Forward Spiral  
Waltz Jump  
F.O.3 Turn  
One foot spin

#### **Green:**

Three jumps (no higher than toe loop)  
Two Spins  
Two Field Moves

### Freeskate Events:

#### **Pre-Primary:**

Must not have passed any Skate Canada Tests.  
Program must contain the elements listed below.  
1) Forward one foot spin  
2) Backwards crosscuts  
3) Waltz jump  
4) Shoot the Duck  
5) Backwards outside development (step, step, edge)  
Program length 1:00 minute

#### **Primary:**

Must not have passed Preliminary Freeskate test or more than 2 Preliminary dances.  
Program length: 1.0 to 1.5 minutes.

#### **Pre-Preliminary Freeskate:**

Must not have passed the Preliminary Freeskate test but has passed at least one complete set of dances.  
Program length: 1.5 to 2.0 minutes

**Preliminary:**

Must have passed the Preliminary Freeskate test  
Program length 2.0 minutes

**Junior Bronze:**

Must have passed the complete Junior Bronze Freeskate test.  
Program length: 2.5 minutes.

**Senior Bronze:**

Must have passed the complete Senior Bronze Freeskate test.  
Program length: 3.0 minutes

**Junior Silver:**

Must have passed the complete Junior Silver Test.  
Program length: 3.5 minutes

**Senior Silver:**

Must have passed the complete Senior Silver Freeskate test.  
Program length: 3.5 minutes

**Gold:**

Must have passed the complete Gold Freeskating test  
Program length:4.0 minutes

**Interpretive Events:****Mystery Interpretive Event:**

Skaters will skate to and interpret “Mystery “ music.  
Each skater will listen to the music then skate to the “Mystery Music” selection.  
Speak to your coach for further information!

Mystery Event “A” (For Bronze Skaters only)

Mystery Event “B” (For Silver and Gold Skaters)

**Introductory Interpretive Event:**

Must be working on or have passed the Introductory Interpretive test, but not the Bronze Interpretive test.  
Program length 2.00minutes – 3.00 minutes

**Bronze Interpretive Event:**

Must have passed the Bronze Interpretive test but not the Silver Interpretive test.  
Program length: 2.00 minutes – 3.00 minutes.

**Silver Interpretive Event:**

Must have passed the Silver Interpretive test but not the Gold Interpretive test.  
Program length: 2.00 minutes – 3:00 minutes

**Gold Interpretive Event:**

Must have passed the Gold Interpretive test.  
Program length: 2:00minutes – 3:00 minutes.

**Solo Dance Events:****Please Note: Determination of Final Dance Results:**

In the event of a tie after both dances have been skated, the skater placing higher in the second dance will place higher in the overall results.

**Pre-Preliminary:**

Skaters must not have passed the complete Preliminary Dance test. The following two Compulsory dances will be skated.  
Dutch Waltz, Canasta Tango

**Preliminary:**

Skaters must have passed the complete Preliminary Dance test but not the complete Junior Bronze Test. The following two compulsory dances will be skated.  
Baby Blues, Fiesta Tango.

**Junior Bronze:**

Skaters must have passed the complete Junior Bronze Dance test but not the Senior Bronze test. The following two compulsory dances will be skated  
Willow Waltz, Ten-Fox.

**Senior Bronze:**

Must have passed the complete Senior Bronze Dance test but not the Junior Silver test. The following two compulsory dances will be skated.  
Fourteen step, Keats Foxtrot.

**Junior Silver:**

Skaters must have passed the complete Junior Silver Dance test but not the Senior Silver test. The following two compulsory dances will be skated  
Rocker Foxtrot, Paso Doble.

**Senior Silver:**

Skaters must have passed the complete Senior Silver Dance test but not the Gold test. The following two compulsory dances will be skated.  
Blues, Quickstep.

**Gold:**

Skaters must have passed the complete Gold Dance test. The following two compulsory Dances will be skated.  
Viennese Waltz, Argentine Tango.
